WBDC Competitive Hair/Make-Up

Make-Up:

Please feel free to buy whatever brands you would like that works best for your skin, allergies, and budget! As long as the end product looks the same, that is all that matters!

- Base and powder to match your skin tone to create a clear complexion. Please be cautious with the base on those younger than 13. (We are not trying to create an unnatural looking face color!)
- Medium Shade of brown eye shadow (for lids), Darker Shade of brown eye shadow (or crease and a little above the lid), Light Shade of brown/highlighter (for under brow and in corner of eye). Remember this is for stage, it SHOULD be a lot darker than what you would wear normally.
- Fake Eyelashes (trim sides if needed for younger dancers), black/brown eyeliner under eye and to connect to fake lashes (no fishtails or lines to the side), mascara on lower lashes.
- Peach/Pink Blush on cheek bones to create high cheek bones & to add color to face.
- Wet'n'Wild Perfect Pout Lip Color 785A "Club Brat"
- Any specialty make-up or alternative colored lipstick will be provided with costume or available for purchase at WBDC.

Hair:

- Left side part, even with center of left eye (pupil). Part length should end even with ears (side of face).
- Wet hair with spray bottle, apply hair gel, or what is needed to get hair ready for a slick pony tail.
- Pull all hair into a low ponytail even with ears. Make sure to use 2 pony binders to make it tight.
- Make sure all bangs and layers are secure and slicked back with gel for a smooth look. Hair should look wet.







• Do NOT use any kind of a bun form. Hair should be twisted and wrapped around in a circle to make a bun. The ends of the hair should be tucked under the bun. Do NOT use a binder after the hair is put into a bun. The top edges of the bun should be hair pinned flat to the head. Use a hair net and continue to pin bun down. Make sure hair binders can not be seen!









• Finished hair should look like the pictures below. Make sure to use lots of hairspray! (Any head piece needed around the bun will come with your costume.)





Helpful Hints and Things that are needed:

- Slightly Dirty Hair (unless hair is naturally oily)
- Hair Binders that match hair color
- Hair Net that matches hair color
- Bobby pins/hair pins that match hair color
- Spray water Bottle
- Comb, Brush, etc.
- LOTS OF GEL AND HAIR SPRAY
- PRACTICE!!!!!!!!!!!!

We understand that everyone's hair is different! If it works better to straighten your dancer's hair, to put it in a pony tail wet, or anything that is different than the steps above, that is fine! This is a guideline. The end result of a slicked back low bun (with no bun form) and a part on the left side is all we are looking for! ©
